## U-17 and U-19 District Level Cricket Tournament

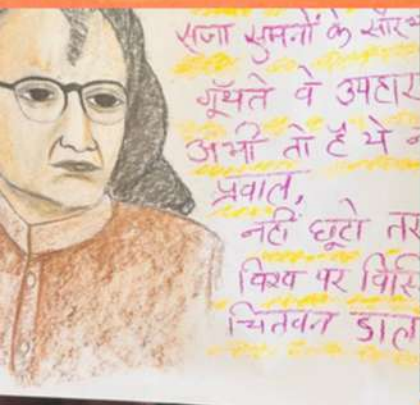
