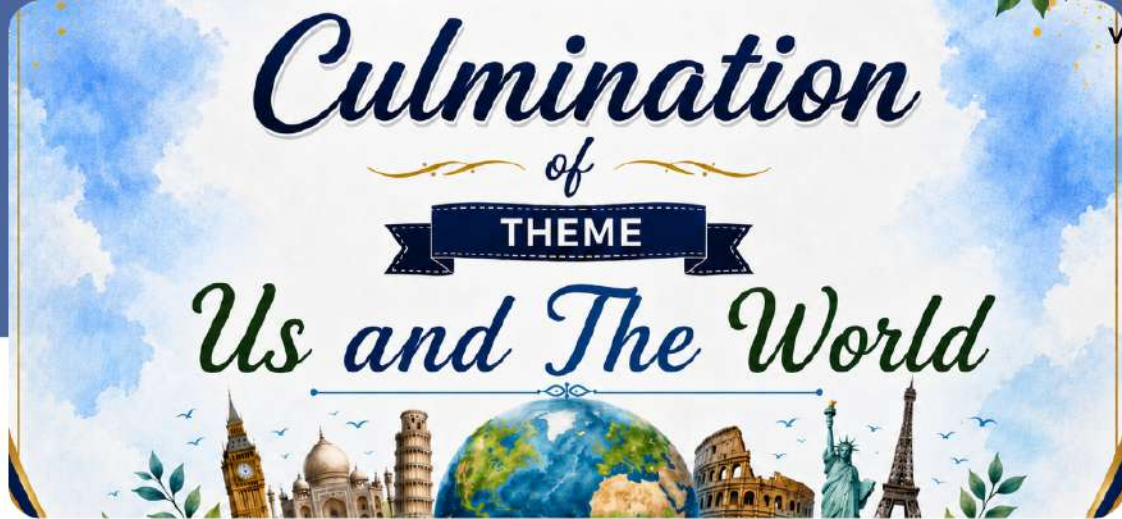


FELICITATION CEREMONY

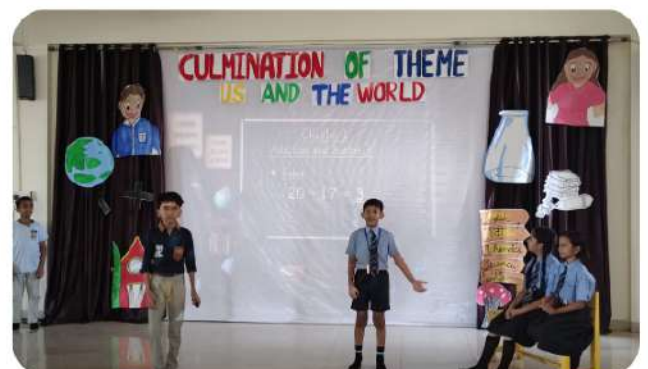
